Buried and Alive

Wade makes Luke perform several degrading tasks to make up for the embarrassment, including a few business operations that Luke ends up screwing up. Things start to work themselves out. Wade and Luke go back to get the car and the car starts right up for Luke. It's similar to a play from the Love Bug in the car's personality. So the car is somewhat of a character in this episode. Luke ends up buying the car back from Wade for \$75.00, only because that's all he has left.
